The two [2] Brown's Gas generators will be provided by Water Fuel LLC, who will be contracted on a Consultant level to initiate and guide the development of the Pilot Program.

- Experimentation with Propane Fuel shows upwards of a 45% reduction in total fuel requirements, while maintaining an equivalent BTU production
- It is estimated that a reduction in coal requirements of one [1] ton per hour, in a sixteen [16] ton per hour Facility, can be achieved with use of the two [2] Generators
- The ROI is estimated at approximately 1 month
- The one [1] year savings of the sixteen [16] ton per hour power Facility, based on the cost of coal being \$25.00 per ton (as per IEA), is estimated at approximately \$250,000
