



PM Teamwork is an online tool for people working together on a case study. The objective of the learning exercise is to develop managerial skills and techniques via online collaborative work. Contrary to individual e-learning, all decisions will be discussed and validated by the team. There are different types of exercises:

- *Multiple choice questions:* all participants individually choose one of four options. They can see other votes and change their choices until the majority of the team has voted for an option. After that, his/her choice cannot be changed. However, if the participant did not vote, he/she can only vote once.

- *Open-ended questions:* the team has to submit a textual answer to the question that will be evaluated by the trainer.

There are several courses:

Technology Project

Case study of managing a six-month project from the planning phase to final closure with typical situations and problems to resolve.

Learning hours: 4 hours; 50 multiple choice questions.

Leading Project Team

Case study of the typical challenges managers face while leading teams.

Learning time: 6 hours; 50 questions (25 open-ended questions).

Customized Scenario

A trainer can easily create a "story" oriented to his/her customer's environment. The trainer can choose several of 250 existing general questions and add new specific situations.
