We should not take advantage of the opportunity that we are confronted with considering the large volume of requirements that has sprung our way especially in the past few months," said Del Campo. "We should adhere to our concept of providing quality results at a reasonable price. Let us not allow ourselves to just be a scapegoat at these times."

It has been part of the concerns of economists in the US that this recession that they're currently experiencing is largely brought about by the moves of companies to bring their jobs offshore because of the low cost that they get in doing so.

Mr. Del Campo refuses to believe that outsourcing is largely the cause of the widespread recession in the US. "We do not see ourselves as taking advantage simply because our labor costs are cheaper. On the contrary, I'd like to think that they go to us because of the quality of work that we provide."

Being one of the founders of the Organization of Outsourcing Companies in the Philippines, Del Campo stressed on the issue of the importance to quality and not volume. He further added that they are the first business that would feel this downtrend of economies therefore they should not make their foreign partners feel that they intend to take over their workforce.

Instead, he urged his fellow members to act reasonably in order to show that they aim to support and not take away jobs.
