After the passage of the UIGEA (Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act), many of the largest online poker rooms left the US market, because of fiduciary responsibilities to their shareholders. Because of this, it is commonly misconceived that the UIGEA made playing online poker in the US illegal. While the name certainly suggests this would be the case, there is no provision in the act that addresses playing poker or any players that might do so. This act was directly aimed at financial institutions and poker rooms to make it more difficult for US players to deposit and thus cut off the ability for US players to play for real money. Keep in mind there are some state laws that specifically prohibit US players within those states from playing online poker or at online casinos. Because of this law, it has been increasingly difficult to deposit onto online poker rooms for US players. In most cases, US players can no longer simply deposit using a major credit card.
