**Roni Lynn Deutch, A Professional Tax Corporation Successfully Ended IRS Collections On Taxpayers Owing The IRS \$2.1 Million**

"Every day it seems like there is a story in the news about how the American economy is collapsing. The other day I read a study that said that 8 out of every 10 Americans are stressed about the economy and their personal finances," claims Roni Deutch. "From sky high gas prices and increasing unemployment rates, many taxpayers are now finding themselves unable to meet basic living expenses. If this hardship is coupled with a debt to the Internal Revenue Service, it is easy to understand why many of these individuals lose hope."

However, hope can be right around the corner for many individuals owing the IRS. In fact, in September 2008 alone, Ms. Deutch and her law firm, Roni Lynn Deutch, A Professional Tax Corporation represented a group of clients owing the IRS \$2.1 million in aggregate. Once the IRS places a taxpayer's account into Currently Not Collectible status, the IRS immediately ceases all collection activity against the taxpayer. Thus, the IRS will no longer issue collection notices, notices of intent to levy, final notices, or a notice of levy. In addition, the IRS will immediately stop any active levies on bank accounts or income, or already in place wage garnishments.

However, interest and penalties will continue to accrue until the tax liability is paid in full or expires. In addition, the IRS may issue a federal tax lien against the taxpayer to protect the outstanding debt. Finally, if the taxpayer's financial situation improves, the IRS can remove the individual from Currently Not Collectible status and ask them to begin making payments.

"When it comes to tax debt, sometimes people do not realize that they have options," explains Ms. Deutch. "The IRS is willing to negotiate, and even cease collections, if you show them that you cannot afford to fully repay your tax liability. The lawyers at my law firm are skilled at negotiating with the IRS and know how to get taxpayers the resolutions they deserve."
