Parents can also click on the "A-Z" index for a complete list of symptoms. The links are directed to a source page, which lists a definition, symptoms and causes.

A symptom checker shouldn't replace the actual exam. Only use online tools as a reference to gather information before a doctor's appointment. With solid background information, it's easier for Dr. Jamali to identify the cause of the illness and offer a proper treatment plan.
