The education will be provided by local fire fighters, emergency responders, and law enforcement. Adult volunteers will assist with tours and general operations.

"The main building is the most complex and expensive part of the school since it will contain all the water, electrical, and other utility junctions for Nana's Safety Village. The downturn in the economy slowed donations and slowed the construction timeline" commented Chapman. "Once it's open, Nana's Fire and Safety School will be another family-friendly place to visit, like the Carlsbad Caverns, Living Desert Zoo and Gardens, and Pecos River Beach."

Nana's Interactive Exhibit will be open 10:00am to 2:00pm on the second Saturday of every month. The entry is on the east side of the Permian Basin Regional Training Center – 1500 Commerce Drive, Carlsbad, NM.
