## Dreamweaver Collection

Inspired by travels across Indonesia's beautiful islands, TAMGA's first women's collection translates the country's most stunning and exotic textile traditions into versatile, standout pieces.

TENCEL® - The majority of our clothing is made from woven and knit TENCEL®, a fibre that harnesses the power of nature to make what might be the most luxurious fabric we have ever felt. It is harvested from FSC certified Eucalyptus forests, and over 99% of the solvents and water used in producing it are recycled in a closed loop process. It's been called the 'fibre of the future' - we tend to agree.

**Modal -** Like TENCEL®, Lenzing Modal comes from wood - Beechwood to be exact. Austrian company Lenzing AC is at the cutting Edge of sustainable technology, and this fabric is no exception. While other Modal has contributed to clear cutting of forests and the dispersal of harmful Chemicals into the environment, this fabric is made from 100% sustainable forests with over 95% of water and solvents being recycled.





**Organic Cotton -** Conventional cotton uses more insecticides than any other crop in the world, and is responsible for 11% of the world's pesticide usage. The impact on the health of ecosystems and the workers who pick it blew us away. TAMGA uses only GOTS certified organic cotton from Gujarat, India, that is grown without the use of harmful chemicals.

Low-Impact and Natural Dyes - Conventional synthetic dyes are some of the worst environmental offenders in the garment industry, alongside the many risks they present to human health. Recognizing that there are better options available, TAMGA gets its brilliant colours through either low-impact or natural dyes, ensuring that absolutely no harmful chemicals end up in the environment or next to your skin.
